Thank you for your interest in CCMC! We hope you'll be able to attend camp this year.

To apply for a scholarship, you must first register for camp and pay a \$50 deposit. Then, fill out the form below and return it *within two weeks* by doing one of the following:

We'll notify you of our decision as soon as possible, no later than June 30.

CCMC offers scholarships of up to half of the tuition (full tuition is \$1,300). Please consider how much assistance you'll need to be able to come to camp.

CCMC is funded by tuition and donations. Each year, our goal is to break even, which can be challenging. So, as much as we'd love to offer scholarships to everyone who asks, we can't.

If we can't offer you a scholarship:

- Your full deposit will be returned and your registration voided.
- If you wish to come to camp as a full-paying student, you'll need to register again. We will not reserve a space for you if we can't offer you a scholarship.
